

LIVESTOCK SHOW GENERAL RULES

Entry Deadline—See Division Rules for arrival and release times.

1. Each exhibitor in Breed Classes must produce papers if called on by the Division Chairman.
2. All livestock exhibitors are subject to the latest rules, and regulations of the Texas Animal Health Commission and health papers must be presented to representatives of TAHC if requested.
3. Entry fees are as follows:

Jr. Steers.....	\$10.00 per head
Junior Lambs.....	\$10.00 per head
Jr. Meat Goats.....	\$10.00 per head
4. All livestock must be gentle and capable of being handled in such a manner so that it will not endanger the safety of the public.
5. The Blanco County Fair Association will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage to livestock or exhibit.
6. The Blanco County Fair Association is not responsible for any damage or injury caused by livestock exhibits. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for injury or damage to, or arising from any animal and shall indemnify the Association against all legal responsibility.
7. There will no opened face fans allowed in the livestock barns.
8. Exhibit cattle will be allowed on a space available basis. A charge of \$25.00 per head is due upon arrival.
9. There will be no open cattle breeding show.
10. Classes for heifers exhibited by junior exhibitors will be set up as entries are received.

1. The show will be broken into 3 breeds:
 - American Cross
 - British Cross
 - Exotic Cross
2. CLASS PREMIUMS
Entry fee will be jack-potted and paid to the top entries in each class. Added money from Fair Association will be paid.
3. AWARDS
 - Junior Showmanship
 - Senior Showmanship
4. CLASSES
Weight will determine class. Not more than 10 head per class.
5. Steers and heifers are subject to all General Rules.
